Jesus and Sport

As the world views people share and experience changes, as churches we need to adapt and find ways to engage with children and their families. One of the ways I have been able to do this is through sports ministry. Using resources from both Kick and Scripture Union we have built a strong foundation to sports ministry in our Church. Within each of these sessions there are opportunities for children and young people hear the stories from the Bible whilst exploring key themes, questioning what they hear to deepen their knowledge all whilst learning a new sport .

'Wonder Time' Janice Midwood

Janice is one of the Wonder Time storytellers who take bible stories to years 1 and 2 children at Filey CofE Primary School. Wonder Time grew out of the interpretation of Godly Play UK, a Christian movement centred on childhood spirituality, for which she completed the training some years ago. Like Godly Play, Wonder Time uses resources and a short script to tell the bible stories. Janice will bring a selection of bible stories with her so you can see for yourselves how the resources were made and will tell one of the stories so you can experience for yourselves how they are told.

3. Buildings for Mission

Our church buildings are the visible, tangible sign of a Christian presence in every community. Their upkeep can indeed be challenging, but they are also an open door, a place of refuge, a house of prayer, a worship space, the place from which we go out to serve our neighbours, and the place to which we invite them to join us in Living Christ's Story. Catherine Copp (DAC Secretary) and Viv Cooling (Funding and Community Engagement Adviser) will share some ideas on how to make the best use of your church building, the resources and advice available within the Diocese, and how to seek the permissions and access the grant funding you will need to make your plans become reality"

4. Finance and Generosity How do we respond to God's abundance of generosity to us?

In this session, Phil McBride, Generous Giving Advisor for the Diocese of York will explore how the Bible demonstrates the amazing generosity of God and gives practical steps to how this can be implemented in churches. He will also look at the mechanisms that can help to grow churches, both in terms of the number of people attending and the financial position and will bring the experience of working with over 100 churches in the past year to talk about what works, and what is more challenging. Phil McBride was a secondary mathematics teacher in Leeds and York for 25 years before joining the Diocese of York in 2022.
